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AUDAC SIGNS LICENSING AGREEMENT FOR FISHER BERKELEY/EKTACOM NURSE CALL SYSTEMS

SAN RAFAEL, CA MARCH 10, 2006: AUDAC has entered into a licensing agreement with Indiana based Hill-Rom Corporation. This agreement will allow AUDAC access to the appropriate proprietary information, software, drawings, schematics and suppliers necessary to produce replacement parts for the Fisher Berkeley MMC-2 series and HV-4 series Nurse Call systems. AUDAC has been negotiating this deal with Genevia Liu, Hill Rom workflow solutions division since the catastrophic warehouse fire which occurred on December 22nd, 2005 destroyed the complete Fisher Berkeley inventory. AUDAC is encouraging Fisher Berkeley customers to establish accounts with AUDAC and to place Purchase Orders for needed parts. Initial delivery dates are anticipated to range from 6-12 weeks. Orders will be filled on a first come first serve basis. The initial focus on procurement of raw materials and production is based upon the Fisher Berkeley

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products that have shown a history of higher demand such as the single patient station Model# HPCB-10, HPCB-10-COSC and dual patient stations Model # HPCB-20 and HPCB-20-COSC, The corridor dome light plastic lens cover, The HSS-21 shower station and the replacement cords, The Model# HCB-21 Code Blue Station and the HSE-21 Staff Assist station as well as the Model # HVB-10 and HVB-20 Patient stations for the HV-4 series Tone/Visual system. Additional items will be added later.

Internationally there is an estimated 3,000 Health care Facilities with one or more Fisher Berkeley Nurse call systems.

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
